THE BANGLADESH (VESTING OF PROPERTY AND ASSETS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1972.

Whereas it is expedient to amend the Bangladesh (Vesting of Property and Assets) Order, 1972 (P.O. No. 29 of 1972), for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

Now, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Proclamation of Independence of Bangladesh, read with the Provisional Constitution of Bangladesh Order, 1972, and in exercise of all powers enabling him in that behalf, the President is pleased to make the following Order:—

- 1. (1) This Order may be called the Bangladesh (Vesting of Property and Assets) (Amendment) Order, 1972.
  - (2) It shall come into force at once.

2. In the Bangladesh (Vesting of Property and Assets) Order, 1972. (P. O. No. 29 of 1972), in Article 2, in clause (1), after the words "Government of Pakistan" the words and comma "or, any officer appointed by such Government" shall be inserted and shall be deemed to have always been so inserted.
